

Bridger PTA Meeting Minutes
May 13, 2008

Called to order: 6:35pm

Heather introduced a representative from the church around the corner (in the old eastgate theater building).

He talked about there new summer program that has been approved by the FDA to provide summer activates and meals for children. This program is to run from June 30th to August 29. Hours are 10am to 2pm. Cost is free. You can drop off your child or stay. They can come daily or once in a while. There will be activates that take place also, such as crafts, trip to the Bridger playground. All children to adult ratios will be followed and all volunteer staff will be screened.

Tina talked about the districts discussion about remodeling or tearing done the building. Tina provided us with a slide show; which the district has given to all principals.

Heather updates us on the sign for in front of the school. She has received emails from a district person who has unofficially approved the sign. The district will provide an approval letter once the PTA can tell them they have all the funds available.

Jackie Lille talked about the pros and cons of switching to a PTC next year and dissolving the PTA in August. There will be a small amount of paperwork needed, but it would be easy. We talked about having to get a new Non Profit number and closing and reopening a new bank account. It was put to a vote and passed to change over in August and September.
